Back to basics camping

Campsite Rules

These rules are intended to provide a safe and enjoyable environment for all site users. Serious breaches will lead to exclusion from the site.

Arrival

Weekend access to the site is from 18:00 hrs Friday to 16:00 hrs Sunday. Arrival or departure outside these times is by prior arrangement only.

Group leaders / representatives should report to the reception upon arrival on site with their Evacuation Sheets for the group.

Booking arrangements may be varied on arrival if site staff considers it necessary due to weather or other activities on site.

Vehicles

The campsite speed limit is 5 miles per hour.

All vehicles should display sidelights when moving around the site.

Crew vehicles will display hazard lights when moving around the site.

All vehicles will park in the designated parking areas only.

No vehicles are to drive on grass. Trailers are to be hand pulled to site.

Whilst on site

The Campsite takes no responsibility for personal items, cars or trailers on the site.

Groups are requested to inform the camp staff if they are leaving site for offsite activities, and also give their expected time of return.

Groups are requested to consider others and to be quiet after 23:00.

Generators are allowed but should be silent between 23.00 and 7.00.

Personal radios, music players, etc. used without ear/headphones are not permitted.

No fires except in the Alter fires provided. Alter fires are to be used on the concrete pads or on metal sheets.

Ashes are to be bagged when cold and disposed of in the skip. Unused wood should be returned to the woodpile prior to departure.

No holes are to be dug for any purpose, including of pioneering and wet pits.

Rubbish is to be placed in the skip provided.

Ensure that bags are not kept outside at night to deter scavenging animals.

Dogs are permitted at the discretion of camp staff as long as they remain leashed at all times. You are responsible for all fowling and must ensure a clean environment.

Camp staff will carry out occasional inspections. Requests should be followed to ensure a safe, clean and friendly environment.

Campsite rules

Toilets and showers

Hot water is not to be taken for camp use.

There are designated areas for washing pots in both toilet sections.

The block is not to be used as a meeting place or venue for any activities.

Users who book the whole site are to maintain the toilet block and ensure they are clean when they handover at the end of their hire.

Woodland

The woodland does not belong to Silverwood, and access is permissive. The general public also have permissive access.

Supervised activities in the woods are permitted.

Dead wood (laying on the floor and not on the trees) may be taken.

No saws or axes are permitted in the wood.

Equipment

Equipment and activity items may not be removed from site, unless they have been hired for offsite use.

Equipment and activity items should be returned to its collection point, dismantled, in good clean working order.

Report any breakages or damage to staff.

Accidents

All accidents must be reported to the camp staff and an accident report sheet filled in prior to departure (available upon request).

Groups are expected to bring their own first aid equipment.

Departure

Group leaders should report to the reception 30 minutes before departure to request a site inspection or building handover.

You should have a work party available to ensure that any additional cleaning or tidying up is completed prior to departure.

All accounts must be settled prior to departure; unless arrangements have been made before arrival for payment on receipt of invoice (schools and business only).
